EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN / NICOSIA FIR

The Kingdom of Bahrain Civil Aviation Affairs draws the attention of all Bahraini registered aircraft and Bahraini Air Operators that, due to the possible launch of air strikes into Syria with air-to-ground and / or cruise missiles and the possibility of intermittent disruption of radio navigation equipment, due consideration needs to be taken when planning flight operations in the Eastern Mediterranean / Nicosia FIR.

The Lebanese DGCA recommends that all traffic departing and arriving from/to Beirut use the routes in the southern part (G/UG2 and R/UR219) with regard to overflying Nicosia FIR.

All Bahraini Operators are required to check any relevant NOTAMS.

These publications are issued under my authority in accordance with Bahrain Civil Aviation Law No.14/2013.
